

Harold Zandvliet earned a MSc degree in Applied Physics at the University of Twente in 1986 followed by a PhD degree in 1990 in the field of condensed matter physics. He then joined Philips Research in Eindhoven, where he worked as a scientific staff member in the department headed by Prof. Andries Miedema. Since June 2005 he is a full professor at the University of Twente. He has spent sabbaticals at the Max Planck Institute Stuttgart (2002) and Forschungszentrum Jülich (2018). From January 2010 till January 2017 Harold Zandvliet served as chairman of the editorial board of Journal of Physics Condensed Matter. He is also member of the advisory editorial board of Applied Surface Science. Harold Zandvliet is an elected Fellow of the IOP (Institute of Physics) and APS Outstanding referee.
